1) Progress Can Still Happen Years After a Severe Brain Injury

Progress is not always dramatic, but even small gains can improve confidence, comfort, and independence for both the individual and their family.

When movement becomes limited, it is easy for the body to lose strength, coordination, balance, and mobility over time. Consistent therapy, guided exercise, and neurological stimulation can help maintain abilities and reduce decline. Long-term support is often just as important as early rehab.
